Order No. 2 Dated 23rd August, 2025.

An application is taken out by the complainant Mr. Mridul Beria for correction of the Order passed by the undersigned on 9th August, 2025. It is submitted by learned Counsel appearing for the complainant that disproportionate ticket allocation to NCC as one of the root causes for refusal to give complementary tickets to the life members is not the allegation of the complainant, though it was recorded as such in the last line of the first paragraph of the order being no 1 dated 9th August, 2025.

It is thus clarified that the said allegation is the complaint of the complainants in the case of Madhusudan Das Mundhra & ors. The application for clarification of the order dated 9th August, 2025 is disposed of.

Mr. Bhattacharya, learned Counsel for Mr. Mridul Beria and Mr. Sen learned Counsel for CAB submit that since, there are also other issues involved in this complaint, let this complaint be heard by the undersigned independently. It is thus, directed that this complaint will be dealt with independently. The order being no. 1 dated 9th August, 2025 is thus modified accordingly.

On the prayer of Mr. Sen, learned Senior Counsel appearing for CAB, leave is granted to CAB to file opposition to the said complaint by 15.09.2025; reply if any by the complainant by 22.09.2025. Let this matter be placed for hearing on 11th October, 2025 at 6:30 p.m.

CAB is directed to communicate this order to all concerned, at the earliest.
