Order No. 9 Dated 27th June, 2026.

At the very outset it is pointed out by Mr. Mukherjee that the direction passed upon Mr. Das in the Order Being No. 7 dated 31st January, 2026 has not been complied with by Mr. Das. He pointed out that no notice has yet been served upon the complainant intimating the documents on which Mr. Das will rely upon at the time of hearing, in addition to the documents which were disclosed by him in his pleadings.

He thus contended that since no such notice has yet been served upon his client since January 2026, despite direction being passed in this regard, by the Undersigned, it will be presumed that apart from the documents which he disclosed in his pleadings, he does not have any other document in his possession on which he wants to rely upon.

Since the Order as referred to above has not been complied with and no extension has also been prayed for disclosure of any documents apart from the documents which had already been disclosed, he will not be permitted to disclose any further document in this proceeding.

Mr. Sengupta, Ld. Counsel appearing for Mr. Das pointed out from an earlier Order passed by the Undersigned that his client was permitted to cross-examine Dr. Mandal/the complainant with, regard to the affidavit-of-evidence submitted by him in this proceeding.

Accordingly, he is permitted to cross-examine Dr. Mandal/the complainant herein.

Dr. Mandal is cross-examined in part. He will be further cross-examined on **6th July, 2026 at 11:00 a.m.**

Venue will be arranged by Mr. Das preferably at Chowringhee Court Chambers, 4th Floor, 55&55/A Chowringhee Road, Kolkata – 700071. Venue charges will be paid by Mr. Das.

CAB is directed to communicate this order to all concerned, at the earliest.
